

BOARDING INFORMATION

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

We offer boarding services for cats and dogs by reservation only. We only have limited boarding room, so we can only provide boarding services for our established clients. In order to become established you must first set up an appointment with one of our doctors and have your pet's vaccine record and medical history transferred to us.

Drop your pet off for boarding Monday through Friday 7:00 am to 6:00 pm and Saturday 7:30 am to 12:00 noon. Pick up times for boarders is 2:30 pm to 6:00 pm Monday through Friday and 7:30 am to 12:00 noon on Saturday. We are not open for drop offs and pick-ups on Sundays and major holidays.

All dogs that stay with us get walked twice a day in our fenced in yard as well as enjoy some outside play in an exercise run on one of our covered porches (weather permitting). If your pet(s) needs a little more exercise, we offer additional ten minute walks for a small fee.

We can administer medication to your pet(s) for an additional charge. You may also bring your pet(s)' own food or we will provide food during their stay.

Upon request, we can bathe your pet for an additional charge before they go home.

We will offer your best friend everything they need to have a fun and safe stay with us. We provide blankets for all boarders so they have a soft surface to lie on. Personal items may be left only at your own risk. We are not responsible for loss or damage.

While your pet is here they will be loved and cared for by our amazing kennel staff. You can rest easy knowing that your pet's veterinarian is here if any health concern arises.

A. Vaccines:

In order to board your pet(s), his/her rabies vaccine must be up to date as well as DHPP and Bordetella vaccines for dogs and DRC vaccine for cats. We also require that all dogs have an up to date (within the last 12 months) fecal floatation test and upon testing if internal parasites are present, treatment will be required.

If your pet has not been vaccinated with us, where can we get an up to date vaccine record? *If possible, please bring a copy of your pet's most recent vaccine record

***We will treat any pet(s) that boards with us if there is any evidence of fleas.**

Should the pet(s) identified on this record become ill, I hereby request that Lawndale Veterinary Hospital provide all responsible medical/surgical treatment it deems necessary. I acknowledge that in the event of my pet's illness, the staff of Lawndale Veterinary Hospital may not be able to contact me immediately and is therefore authorized to initiate appropriate treatment until I or another emergency contact can be reached. I agree to pay all related expenses associated with the treatment of my pet(s) until I am available to discuss further care and costs with the attending veterinarian.

I agree to make complete payment to Lawndale Veterinary Hospital at the time of discharge.

I certify that my pet(s) appears to be free of contagious disease and has/have not bitten anyone within the last ten days.

I understand that if I fail to pick up my pet(s) within ten days of notification, my pet(s) will be considered to be "abandoned", and will be handled in accordance with North Carolina State Law, and that doing so does not relieve me of my financial obligations.
